36-42	Advanced Level 3	Mix of AS and Applied GCE (with preference on Applied), BTEC Nationals	Sat a range of GCSEs at end of Year 11 with 5A*- C grades. Takes 3 Advanced subjects and is more likely to choose Applied GCE courses and/or BTEC Nationals.
30-36	Intermediate Level 2	BTEC Firsts, OCR Nationals Level 2, GCSE's	Sat a range of GCSE at end of Year 11 with most passes around Grade D. Selects a Level 2 course in order to gain entry to Advanced level, apprenticeships, college or employment.
Below 30	Foundation Learning Tier - Level 1	BTEC Introductory, OCR Nationals - Level 1	Sat a range of GCSEs at end of Year 11 with most passes around grades E-G. Selects Level 1 courses to prepare for college or employment.
